The Muskegon Housing Commission is requesting cost proposals for the installation of a gas fired forced air heating system to service the Housing Commission Office located at 1080 Terrace Street Muskegon, MI 49442.

Specifications include but not limited to:

- Heil Upper Line Model, 60,000 BTUH, 95% AFUE, single stage, single speed furnace, or equal.
- Heil digital programmable thermostat
- Connect new PVC vent and terminate
- Connect electric, gas and thermostat wire to new furnace
- Fabricate new supply plenum adapter and connect to existing supply duct
- Install new drain line and drain furnace
- Condemnation of existing unit heater above ceiling electric unit.
- Duct work modifications as necessary
- Install a new return air duct to be located centrally in office complex
- New gas piping shall be installed by contractor
- Exhausting and intake of the unit shall meet unit requirements and installed by contractor
- Build wall and vented closet door to house furnace unit
- Reconstructing of existing suspended ceiling and ceiling supports an needed
- Contractor to comply with all code requirements, permits and fees.
